DIRECTIONS

Centro Restaurante (at the Mill), 328 Pemberwick Road, Greenwich, CT

Merritt Pkwy N - King St. Exit. Right off exit, 3rd light turn left onto Glenville Rd. At bottom of road, turn right, then take first right onto Pemberwick Rd. The Mill is on the right. Merritt Pkwy South - Exit 27S. Right off the exit, take right back over Merritt. Then follow direx for MP N. I-95 N - Exit 2. Left at stop sign, left at light, right at next light, left onto Byram Rd. At 3rd stop sign, right onto Post Rd. Take immediate left thru the median onto Pemberwick Rd. Follow that to the Mill which is on the left. I-95 S - Exit 2. Go straight through the stop to 2nd right. Take 2nd right onto Byram Rd. Then follow direx for I-95 North.

Char Restaurant, 2 South Water Street, Greenwich, CT

I-95 North (from NY): Exit 21, Portchester, NY. Merge onto U.S. 1 North toward Portchester. Go 1.9 miles and turn right onto Mill St. Take the second right onto South Water St. 2 South Water St. is on the right. I-95 South:

Take Exit 2, Delevan Ave., toward Byram. Stay straight onto Frontage Rd., then turn a slight right onto Delevan Ave. Delevan Ave. becomes Mill St. Turn left onto South Water St. 2 South Water St. is on the right.

Roger Sherman Baldwin Park, 100 Arch Street, Greenwich, CT (at the Island Ferry dock)

I-95 South: Exit 3, turn left onto Arch St., 100 Arch St. is on the right. I-95 North: Exit 3, turn slight right onto Arch St., 100 Arch St. is on right.

Trips, 348 Hope St., Stamford, CT

From I-95 north: Exit 8, turn left on Atlantic St. then right on Tresser
Blvd./U.S. 1 N. Follow U.S. 1 N just
past Champion Plaza.The Rich Forum
Box Office is on the left. Go up the hill.
Turn left onto Glenbrook Road. Walgreens is on the corner. At the split,
stay straight to go onto Hope Street.
348 is on the left. From I-95 south: Exit
9, right on U.S. 1/East Main, 1st right
onto Courtland Ave./CT 106, follow to
end. turn left onto Glenbrook Road.

stay straight to Church Street (with church on your right). Turn right onto Hope Street. 368 is on the left.

Waveny Park, New Canaan, CT

I-95 N/S: Exit 11, keep left to take ramp toward Darien/RR Station. Merge onto Post Road/U.S. 1 N. Turn left onto Mansfield Ave./CT-124. Continue on to South Ave./CT-124. 677 South Ave. is on left. Merritt Pkwy. North or South: Exit 37, take CT-124, toward New Canaan. Turn left onto South Ave./CT-124. 677 is on the left.

Zody's 19th Hole, E. Gaynor Brennan Golf Course, Stamford, CT

From I-95 north: Take exit 6/Harvard Ave. At end of ramp, go straight one block. Turn left at next light onto West Ave., go straight across Post Road, then bear left around the island, turning onto Stillwater Ave. Continue on Stillwater about 1/8 mi. On your right you will see the golf course. Turn into the parking lot. From I-95 south: turn right off of exit 6 onto West Ave., then follow the directions above.
