

#### **DIRECTIONS:**

Lugano, 1392 E Putnam Ave., Old Greenwich

**CT.** I-95 N or S to Exit 5, turn right onto E. Putnam. Lugano is on the right about .4 miles down.

Pasquale's, 2 Putnam Ave., Port Chester, NY.

Take I-95 S to exit 2 in Greenwich. Go straight off exit, then take second right onto Byram Road. Take Byram Road to Putnam Ave. in Port Chester.

Rory's Restaurant, 416 Boston Post Road, Darien, CT. I-95 S: Take exit 13 toward US-1/Post Rd. Turn left onto Boston Post Rd (US-1). Go for 246 ft. Rory's is on the left. I-95 N: Take exit 12 toward CT-136/Tokeneke Rd/Rowayton. Go for 0.1 mi. Turn left onto Tokeneke Rd (CT-136). Go for 0.3 mi.Turn right onto Boston Post Rd (US-1). Go for 0.7 mi. Rory's is three-quarters of a mile up on the right.
