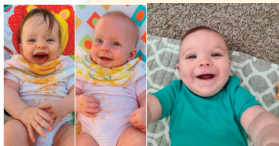
**Winnie Walsh:** Recovering from a broken arm but driving again, physical therapy, enjoying sitting in the yard

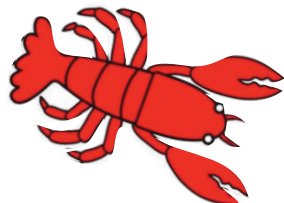
