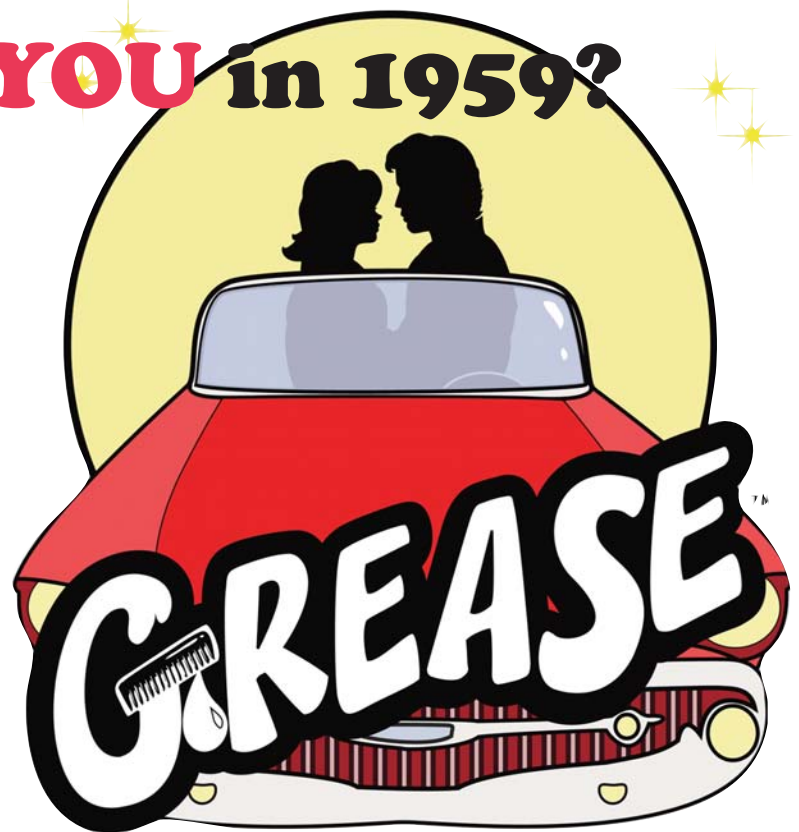

DIRECTIONS

Bistro Versailles, 339 Greenwich Ave., Greenwich, CT

From I-95 southbound take exit 3 and turn right onto Arch Street. Continue on Arch Street 0.5 miles then make a sharp right turn onto Greenwich Avenue. Versailles will be immediately on the left. From I-95 Northbound take exit 3 and turn left onto Arch Street and follow directions above. From Putnam Avenue southbound (also named Post Road and Route 1, turn left onto Greenwich Avenue. Versailles will be approximately 0.5 miles on left after Starbucks on the corner. From Putnam Avenue northbound, turn right on Greenwich Avenue and follow directions above.

Kweskin Theater, Curtain Call Inc., 1349 Newfield Ave., at Sterling Farms Golf Course, Stamford, CT

Merritt Pkwy: Exit 35, rte 137, (High Ridge Rd.). Southbound, turn right toward downtown Stamford. Go under Parkway Bridge and turn left at light. (Buxton Farms Rd.). Northbound, go straight across the intersection onto Buxton Farms Rd. At stop sign turn right onto River Rd. and left onto Intervale Rd. At top of hill turn right onto Newfield Ave. Sterling Farms Golf Course driveway is first left. I-95: Exit 8. From southbound, turn right onto Elm St. From Northbound, go straight three lights and turn left under the highway onto Elm St. Follow Elm St. as it becomes Grove St. and Grove, then Strawberry Hill Ave., then Newfield Ave. About 1.4 miles from Newfield Green shopping center, you will pass the light at Weed Hill Ave. The Sterling Farms Golf Course driveway is about 1/2 mile from the light, on the right.

Trips, 348 Hope St., Stamford, CT From I-95 N: Exit 9, left at light and left at second light, then right onto Courtland Ave./CT 106. Follow to end, turn left onto Glenbrook Road, stay straight to Church Street (with church on your right). Turn right onto Hope Street. 368 is on the left. From I-95 S: Exit 9, right on U.S. 1/East Main, 1st right onto Courtland Ave./CT 106, follow direx above.

Zody's 19th Hole, E. Gaynor Brennan Golf Course, Stamford

From I-95 N: Take exit 6/Harvard Ave. At end of ramp, go straight one block. Turn left at next light onto West Ave., go straight across Post Road, then bear left around island, turning onto Stillwater Ave. Continue on Stillwater about 1/8 mi. On your right you will see golf course. Turn into parking lot. From I-95 S: turn right off of exit 6 onto West Ave., then follow the directions above.
